On Course Tips-Scorecard

Names: Fill in the names of the player and swap cards with your playing partner. You mark **their score** and record it where it says "score" and you record **your** score in the "markers score"

Handicap: This is the number that measures your scoring ability relative to other golfers and the golf course. (You have to be a member of a golf club and return at least 3 scorecards in order to obtain your official WHS handicap so don't worry about this yet!)

Index: Ranking of the holes by degree of difficulty, number 1 is the hardest hole to play, number 18 is the easiest.

Par: The number of strokes a golfer should need to play a particular hole. If the par is 4 and the hole is completed in 4 shots it is a **par**.

Birdie: One under par e.g. par 4, completing the hole in 3 shots is a <u>birdie.</u>

Bogey: One over par e.g. par 4, completing the hole in 5 shots is a **bogey.**

Double Bogey: Two over par e.g. par 4, completing the hole in 6 shots is a **double bogey**.

Triple Bogey: Three over par e.g. par 4, completing the hole in 7 shots is **triple bogey**.

Marking the scorecard: It is important to note that when you start to play in competitions you cannot mark your own card, you must swap with your playing partners and mark their score (under score) and you can also keep track of your own score (under markers score). You can then check your scores at the end of the round.

Signatures: It is very important to always sign the card; make sure to put your signature and your partner's signature on the card AFTER you have finished playing.
